Feilding Brass generally has 35+ players and Youth Band has 15+ players.

Band Rooms

Feilding Brass has dedicated band rooms located at Council Place, Feilding. It includes training rooms, storage facilities for music and instruments, a kitchen and practice room with carpets and heat pumps.

Uniforms

The marching uniform consists of black suits with golden braid, white shirts and black ties. This uniform is worn to CD contests and ANZAC Services.

The concert uniform consists of light green jackets with black trousers, white shirts and black ties. This uniform is worn at festivals, concerts and community play outs.

The informal uniform consists of white polo shirts with black trousers. This uniform is worn to Christmas parades and market day.
